Rebecca Wolf DiBiase is an expert in school district accountability, human resources, performance management, and charter schools. Wolf DiBiase is managing director of programs at The Eli and Edythe Broad Foundation, a national venture philanthropy dedicated to dramatically improving K-12 urban public education through better governance, management, labor relations and competition. She manages the foundation's investments in the strategic redesign of urban school districts through the implementation of performance accountability systems and the improvement of human resources operations. She also oversees the foundation's investments in the expansion of charter schools nationwide, most notably in Los Angeles, New York City and New Orleans. Previously, DiBiase was director of accountability for the Charter School Office of the Massachusetts Department of Education. She also worked for the Pioneer Institute for Public Policy Research, where she focused on policy reforms in K-12 education and urban entrepreneurship. Earlier in her career, DiBiase taught middle school in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. Wolf DiBiase currently sits on the boards of three high-performing charter school management organizations: KIPP L.A., Aspire Public Schools, Calif. and the Alliance for College Ready Schools, Calif.
